Features

- Reinforced wide-open design for effortless line handling.
- Self-draining bottom to prevent water pooling and ensure fast drying
- Fast-fit attachment system using locking slats & mushroom studs - to be glued or screwed (screws and glue not included)

Materials

- Main body: polypropylene fabric, dual-coated for added durability
- Reinforcement: 1.8mm (18/10) polyethylene stiffener
- Base: self-draining, coated polypropylene mesh
- Binding: heavy-duty polypropylene webbing trim

WIDE-OPENING BAYABOUTS TO STORE LINES IN REVERSE-PILED COILS



Feeding from the free end of the line, stow the rope directly into the bag using both hands. This ensures the line is correctly flaked and ready for immediate, snag-free deployment.
